RESULTS OF EXAMINATION

Exhibits A through D were examined resulting in six latent fingerprints and seven latent palm prints that are suitable for identification purposes.

The latent fingerprints were compared, insofar as possible, to the known prints in Exhibits E through H resulting in the following identifications:

JAMES CHRISTOPHER JOHNSON

Five latent fingerprints and two latent palm prints were identified in six photographs taken of the bedroom wall, located at 1732 N. Rhodes Street.


One latent fingerprint and one latent palm print were identified on two latent cards purportedly taken from the interior side front door and left front edge of the bedroom dresser, located at 1732 N. Rhodes Street.
