

Summary

On 8-22-98 at about 1:30 am Chris Johnson reported to the police that he found his girlfriend dead in the closet in their bedroom.

Chris Johnson is a white male, 36 years old, who works for [REDACTED] as a receiving clerk.

The victim, Andrea Lincotta, was a white female, 52 years old, who worked as a liaison librarian for Arlington County.

This couple had been dating for about 10 years and had lived together for about 9 years. They were supposed to be married in about two months when the house they were building together in Bertrand, VA is completed.

However, I have found that Chris Johnson has been sending flowers to other ~~to~~ single women in the condo complex, baking them cookies, cleaning off their cars in bad weather and even went to one of their apartments for dining dinner when Andrea was out of the country visiting her son in England.

When Chris Johnson initially called the police, he reported the following:

He got home from work about 5:30 to 6:00 pm on 8-21-98 (Friday). His girlfriend was not home. He took a shower, then did his laundry in the basement laundry room of the condo building - the whole time waiting for his girlfriend to come home. He then ate a snack + watched TV until about 11:30 pm. He then went to bed about 11:30 pm. Before he went to bed, he called around to see if he could locate Andrea.

At 1:37 am on 8-22-98, he said he woke up and noticed the closet door in the bedroom was closed. He said Andrea always kept the closet door open so he wondered why it was closed. He got up + open the closet door and discovered his girlfriend dead in the closet. He then called the police.
